#### Special Consolidator Fares (Private Leisure / Specialty Fares)

Valid: 06/27/2018 - 09/30/2019

Subject to the terms and conditions of the Agreement, Carriers agree to offer certain consolidator fares as described herein ("Consolidator Fares") to Contractor for air transportation services, and Contractor agrees to pay Carriers for such services. Consolidator Fares and rules are subject to change at any time, without advance notice, and are not guaranteed until ticketed. Unless otherwise explicitly provided for in a contract addendum or fare rule, Consolidator Fares are non-commissionable. Carriers reserve the right to reduce or eliminate the space available to Contractor at any time without advance notice.

- 1) <u>Ticketing and Travel</u> Contractor agrees to comply with all fare rules filed in the GDS and with the following conditions of ticketing and travel in connection with the Consolidator Fares.
  - a. Contractor must abide by the ticketing rules and restrictions of the Consolidator Fares provided to the Contractor, issue tickets using Carriers' ticket validation (001, 075, 125, 131, 105) only and remit payment through ARC or BSP, as applicable.
  - b. Carriers may request that Contractor ticket or cancel ticket reservations when a flight experiences critical demand. If Carriers make such a request, Contractor shall either release such reservations or immediately ticket such reservations and remit payment in full to Carriers.
  - c. All ticketing of Consolidator Fares under this Attachment must be performed by Contractor using its own authorized ARC/IATA location numbers. Carriers acknowledge that Contractor redistributes fares to other agencies, but redistribution of Carriers's net fares to corporate and/or general business agencies is not permitted. All tickets are subject to the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
  - d. In the event of early termination of this Attachment by Carriers for its convenience, or by Contractor due to a default by Carriers, all unticketed inventory reserved by Contractor must be ticketed or cancelled within 30 days of the effective date of termination. At the end of the 30 day period, all unticketed inventory will be canceled.
  - e. In the event of termination under any other circumstances, all unticketed inventory will be cancelled on the effective date of termination, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by Carriers.
- 2) <u>Limitations of Use of Consolidator Fares</u> Contractor acknowledges that Consolidator Fares, schedules and inventory information are and shall remain the sole property of Carriers. Without Carriers's prior written approval, Contractor may not re-market or re-distribute Consolidator Fares (or, if relevant, packages that include Consolidator Fares) to or through other distributors, agents or intermediaries, except for the following authorized persons or entities:
  - a. Persons or entities that have been expressly approved in writing by Carriers and which have acknowledged the foregoing property rights of Carriers and agreed to the restrictions set forth in this paragraph if and as required by Carriers or,
  - b. Non-ARC/IATA accredited entities that do not re-market or redistribute such Consolidator Fares via web sites or other electronic outlets.

Contractor agrees that it is the intent of the parties that Contractor and any such authorized persons or entities market and sell Consolidator Fares (and packages, if relevant) directly to end users. Contractor shall ensure that contracted fares that are sold over the internet, or that result from holding out such fares on the internet (e.g. a telephone or walk in sale resulting from an internet advertisement), are sold in such a manner that the customer cannot determine, until purchase, the identity of Carrier as the carrier that will provide the air travel. Contractor shall take all reasonable steps to prevent any website operated by Contractor from being issued by unauthorized third parties for purposes of accessing contracted fares.

- 3) <u>Liability for Improper use of Consolidator Fares</u> Should Contractor use the Consolidator Fares in an improper manner, then in addition to Carriers's right to terminate this Attachment in accordance with the provisions of Section 4 (Standard Terms and Conditions) of the Agreement, Contractor will also be liable to Carriers for the difference between the private fare used and the full unrestricted fare for the applicable cabin of service (e.g., full F or Y fare) at the time of ticketing, and such fare differential shall be payable to Carriers on demand.
- 4) Performance Requirements Carriers reserve the right to monitor the performance of Contractor hereunder in terms of share of tickets issued by Contractor on Carriers versus other airlines. Repeated failure to maintain a quarterly RSP or PSP greater than or equal to 100.0 for each relevant market could, in Carriers's discretion, cause Contractor to lose access to and use of the Consolidator Fares.
